Drugs and Alcohol

WGTC has adopted a policy in accordance with the federal Drug-Free Schools and Communities Act, which was enacted to ensure that any institution of higher education that receives funds under any federal program has adopted and implemented a program to prevent the use of illicit drugs and abuse of alcohol by students. It also incorporates the statutory mandates required under the state Drug-Free Postsecondary Education Act of 1990 (O.C.G.A. §20-1-20 et seq.)

No student, faculty, or staff member may engage in the unlawful manufacture, possession, use or distribution of illicit drugs and alcohol on WGTC's property or as a part of any of the institution's sponsored activities.
