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### Pre-LPN-to-ADN Admission Requirements

#### Program Specific

- Competitive GPA must be at least a 3.2 in the Courses Required for Competitive Selection (40% of the evaluation process)
- Must have a current unencumbered Georgia and/or eNLC Practical Nurse (LPN) licensure
- Offered at Coweta, Murphy, and LaGrange

### Admission Criteria for LPN-to-ADN Bridge (NL13)

Admission to West Georgia Technical College's Health Sciences and Nursing diploma and degree programs is based on a competitive selection process. There are minimum requirements for admission to individual Health Sciences and Nursing programs, and meeting minimum requirements does not guarantee admission to the program.

Non-Georgia residents shall be enrolled on a space-available basis and shall not displace any student desiring to enroll who is a resident of the state. This applies to programs with limited seating, such as competitive selection Health Sciences and Nursing programs and programs that have a waiting list. ### Competitive Selection Deadlines

- The LPN-to-ADN Bridge program will admit once each year at the LaGrange Campus and the Coweta Campus.
  - **LaGrange Campus** – July 1<sup>st</sup> deadline for Fall semester cohort start date.
  - **Coweta Campus** – October 1<sup>st</sup> deadline for Spring semester cohort start date
    - **Murphy Campus Option** – Students who wish to attend the Murphy Campus for the bridge, may apply to the Coweta cohort. If accepted, student will take the bridge courses during the Spring semester at Coweta. Students may choose to sit out the Summer semester and begin RNSG 2710 at Murphy with the Fall cohort.

## Competitive Selection Requirements

- Must be admitted to the college in good academic standing and regular status.
- Must have a current unencumbered Georgia and/or eNLC Practical Nurse (LPN) licensure.
  - A copy of the license must be attached to the Competitive Selection File Review Request Form.
  - The license must have been obtained within the last five (5) years.
    - *If the licensure was obtained more than five (5) years ago, documentation of a minimum of one (1) year employment as an LPN within the last five (5) must be provided. An employer letter of verification must be submitted on company letterhead and include the dates of employment, job title, and a brief description of duties.*
  - Georgia Licensed LPNs will have higher priority than the out of state LPN licensure.
  - eNLC Licensure with Georgia residence will have same priority as Georgia Licensed LPNs.
  - eNLC Licensure with Georgia residence will have priority over eNLC licensure with other states of residency.
- Non-Georgia residents will be considered in the competitive selection process on a space available basis.
- Must complete the ten (10) required courses and labs with a minimum grade of “C” or higher and have at least a 3.2 competitive GPA (40% of the process).
  - ENGL 1101, PSYC 1101, MATH 1111, BIOL 2113, BIOL 2113L, BIOL 2114, BIOL 2114L, BIOL 2117, BIOL 2117L, and PSYC 2103 are used to calculate the competitive GPA.
  - BIOL courses must be completed within seven (7) years of the program cohort start date.
- Must complete the Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) Exam with a minimum Adjusted Individual Total Score of 75% **and** an Individual Score of 65% in each subject (60% of process).
  - Applicant must earn an Individual Score of 65% on each of the Individual exams to include: Reading, Math, Science, English and Language Usage.
  - TEAS Exam must be current within two (2) years of the program start date; maximum of three (3) attempts allowed per calendar year – minimum of fourteen (14) days required between testing dates.
  - A copy of the highest earned TEAS Score Report must be attached to the Competitive Selection File Review Request Form. WGTC will accept the highest TEAS score report only.
  - Students may schedule the exam through [WGTC Community Education](#).<sup>7</sup>
- Must possess a current CPR certification through the American Heart Association for Healthcare Providers- BLS (Basic Life Support).
  - A copy of current CPR certification must be attached to the Competitive Selection File Review Request Form.
  - Online CPR certification will not be accepted.

### Possible Bonus Point:

- WGTC LPN graduates will get one (1) extra bonus point toward the competitive selection calculation.

## Competitive Selection Process

1. Must attend Mandatory Information session with Advising Coach.
2. Gather all supporting documentation including copies of current CPR card, TEAS Exam score, and current LPN certification or license and save electronically.
3. Complete [Competitive Selection File Review Request Form](#)<sup>8</sup> and attach all supporting documents electronically on or before the deadline (direct questions related to the form to [admissions@westgatech.edu](mailto:admissions@westgatech.edu)).
4. Monitor WGTC student email account and review competitive selection scoring sheet (this does not indicate acceptance or denial to the program cohort).
5. Allow 4-6 weeks from the program deadline date to receive acceptance or denial letter from the Admissions Office.
  - If accepted, respond to secure your seat in the program by the given deadline.
  - If denied, meet with an Advising Coach to determine next steps. Students not selected into the program cohort must submit a new Competitive Selection File Review Request Form and required documentation to be included in the next selection process for the same program or the selection process for another program

**TEAS score minimum: 75% Adjusted Individual score PLUS 65% individual score Reading, Math, Science, and Language Usage.**

- 60% of what the evaluator considers, so study for it like it's a class
- You can take the TEAS 3 times a calendar year; 14 days apart
- **DO NOT WAIT** until just before the deadline to take the TEAS; no guarantee it will be available
- Register for WGTC at **Competitive Selection Process webpage**
- WGTC has 1 test date per month
