

Diesel Engine Service Technician (DE21)- 16 Credit Hours

Program Description:

The Diesel Engine Service Technician certificate program prepares students to inspect, repair, or overhaul buses, trucks, and other vehicles with diesel engines. The topics presented include diesel shop safety and tool use, basic electrical and electronics theory, starting and charging systems, and electronic controls and accessory systems. Graduates may find entry-level employment as diesel engine service technician technicians with auto repair shops, fleet operations, or local government operations servicing diesel vehicles. Salaries in this occupation are estimated to range from \$38,950 - \$59,440 per year (BLS.gov May 2022).
