

Diesel Equipment Technology Diploma (DET4)- 47 Credit Hours (Fall start)

Program Description:

The Diesel Equipment Technology diploma program is a sequence of courses designed to prepare students for careers in the diesel equipment service and repair profession. Learning opportunities enable students to develop academic, technical and professional knowledge and skills required for job acquisition, retention, and advancement. The program emphasizes a combination of truck, heavy equipment, marine systems, or emergency power generator repair theory and practical application necessary for successful employment depending on the specialization area a student chooses to complete. Graduates may find employment as entry-level diesel equipment technicians. Salaries in this occupation are estimated to range from \$38,950 - \$59,440 per year (BLS.gov May equipment-technology/ 2022).
