

Manufacturing Technician Certificate (MT31)- 13 Credit Hours

Program Description:

The Manufacturing Technician certificate program prepares students for entry- Luis Acevedo, Program Chair level employment in a manufacturing environment or for continued education 678-664-0560 in manufacturing or engineering programs of study. Students are introduced to luis.acevedo@westgatech.edu fundamental manufacturing processes, including manufacturing design, machining, and assembly; mathematical operators and analytical problem solving; technical schematics and symbols; drafting tools and techniques; and engineering tools and concepts. All didactic and lab principles are applied as practiced in an industrial setting. Graduates may be employed as manufacturing production technicians or in similar positions in the manufacturing sector. Starting salaries are estimated to start at \$41,000 (BLS.gov May 2022).
