

Heavy Diesel Service Technician Certificate (HD31)- 31 Credit Hours

Program Description:

The Heavy Diesel Service Technician certificate program provides training in theory, diagnosis, and repair of basic systems on diesel engines and diesel equipment. Program instruction includes shop safety, shop equipment, diesel engines and fuel systems, electrical and electronic systems, off road power trains, and heavy equipment hydraulics. Employers in this field look for applicants who have mechanical aptitude and strong problem-solving skills. Technicians constantly receive updated technical manuals and instructions outlining changes in techniques and standards for repair. It is essential that technicians be able to read, interpret, and comprehend service manuals in order to keep abreast of engineering changes. Graduates may find employment as entry-level diesel service technicians. Salaries in this occupation are estimated to range from \$38,950 - \$59,440 per year (BLS.gov May 2022).
