Qualifications/Knowledge:

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Locates, measures and describes new construction by conducting on-site reviews; measures structures to determine square footage; observes quality of materials; checks for permits
- Conducts on-site inspections of existing real estate for any unreturned properties, including mobile homes; notes materials used, quality of labor, amenities, road conditions, utilities and other improvements
- Assists taxpayers and other interested parties by explaining property valuation, describing potential exemptions, explaining tax assessment rules and regulations and defending or justifying assigned property values
- ⇒ Processes real property tax returns
- Defends valuations at Board of Equalization hearings; explains assessment rules and regulations and uses ratio studies and property sales to validate and substantiate property values
- ⇒ Processes appeals by reviewing taxpayer statements and assertions of value; conducts desk or on-site reviews
- **⇒** Assists in compiling and analyzing sales ratio studies
- ⇒ Performs all other related duties as assigned
