The CNC Specialist certificate program provides training for graduates to gain employment as CNC machine tool technicians. Topics include CNC Fundamentals, mill and lathe manual programming, CNC practical applications, tim.white@westgatech.edu and CAD/CAM programming. The program emphasizes a combination of CNC theory and practical application necessary for successful employment. Graduates may find employment as CNC machinist/operators or in related occupations. Salaries in this occupation are estimated at \$33,470 - \$48,510 per year. (BLS.gov May 2022)
