The Precision Machining and Manufacturing diploma program is a sequence of courses that prepares students for careers in the machine tool technology field. Learning opportunities develop academic, technical, and professional knowledge and skills required for job acquisition, retention, and advancement. The program emphasizes a combination of machine tool theory and practical application necessary for successful employment. Graduates may find employment as machine tool technicians or in a related field. Salaries in this occupation are estimated at \$33,470 – \$48,510 per year. (BLS.gov May 2022)
